Residential Service - Home Business
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AVAILABLE

Electric service is available under this schedule in the entire area served by the Board's electric system.

APPLICABLE

To single family residences who meet all of the following requirements:

1. The business will be conducted entirely within a dwelling or integral part thereof.
2. The business is clearly incidental and secondary to the principal use of the dwelling.
3. No mechanical equipment is used except such as may be used for domestic or household purposes (or as deemed similar to power and type).
4. Such business shall not require internal or external alteration or invoke construction features not customarily in a dwelling.
5. Not more than fifty percent of the floor area at the dwelling is devoted to such home business.
6. No sign is displayed other than those permitted for residential purposes.

CHARACTER OF SERVICE

Alternating current, 60 hertz, single phase, 120 or 120/240 volts.

MONTHLY RATE

Service Charge: \$5.50 per customer per month plus,

Energy Charge:

10.17 cents per kWh for the first 600 kWh

12.56 cents per kWh for all usage over 600 kWh

This rate is subject to the Energy Optimization Surcharge and the Renewable Energy Surcharge per schedule of surcharges.

POWER COST ADJUSTMENT (PCA)

The PCA will be increased or decreased by the amount of increase or decrease in the fuel cost per kilowatt hour above or below the base price of 34.25 mils/kWh multiplied by 105%. Power costs include allowed fuel and emission allowance costs for all BLP generation, net purchased power costs including interconnection costs, and renewable energy costs.

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TAX ADJUSTMENT

Bills shall be increased to any customer receiving electric service from the Board of Light and Power within the territorial limits of a tax authority who imposes any new or increased tax on the Board's electric operation after the effective date of this rate schedule. New or increased taxes include franchise, occupation, gross receipts, license, excise, privilege or similar type tax. Each customer's bill affected within the specific territorial limits of a tax authority shall be increased to offset such new or increased taxes in conformity with the basis that such total tax is imposed upon the Board of Light and Power's electric operation.

PAYMENT

Monthly bills will be rendered NET, payable on or before the due date of the net monthly bill. The gross monthly bill which is 102 percent of the net monthly bill, will be collected if the monthly bill is not paid on or before the due date.

TERMS OF SERVICE

1. Single Phase motors not exceeding 3 horsepower per motor and not exceed 10 horsepower total capacity may be included in the service without the specific consent of the Board.
2. At the Board's option, three phase service may be provided under this schedule.
3. Service rendered under this schedule is subject to the Board's standard rules and regulations.
